

2024 SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION PROCESS

Parents' Responsibilities

- All families (including families who are re-enrolling their child from Apple Tree or from previous years of camp) must fill out a registration form.
- A registration form is required for each child being enrolled.
- A registration fee of \$100/camper is required for each camp that you are enrolling in. This registration fee is **non-refundable.**
- A permission form for each family is required for each camper. This form must be submitted at least one week before camp begins.
- A current physical that states the camper is able to attend camp is required for each camper. This form must be submitted at least one week before camp begins.
- Registration forms can be dropped off at the church office, electronically submitted to <u>sara.godwin@broomfieldumc.org</u>, or mailed to the school at 545 W 10th Ave, Broomfield, CO 80020.
- Forms will be accepted on a first come first served basis.

Waitlists

- A camper will be placed on the waitlist for each camp that they are not placed in.
- Emails will be sent out confirming camp placement and/or waitlist status.
- Parents should notify the director as soon as possible when a camper is to be removed from any waitlist(s).

Confirmation of Registration

- An email will be sent with confirmation of acceptance or waitlist status into the camp as registration forms are received. At this time all families will be charged a registration fee of \$100/camp/camper in their Kangaroo Time accounts. The camp director will create the Kangaroo Time accounts and send each family instructions on how to access their account. New families will be asked to enter a credit card or bank account information in their Kangaroo Time account. Returning families will be charged using the payment method listed on their current KT account. If payment information is not received one week after confirmation email is sent, the registration will be considered null and voided. All registration fees are **non-refundable** upon placement in a program.
- The \$100 registration fees will be applied to the camp tuition. Camp tuition must be paid in full one week prior to camp starting.
- Registration closes one week before each camp begins.

Changes in Registration

 Parents should notify the school of any change requests for camp placement as soon as possible. • If parents decide to withdraw a child who has been placed in a camp, the camp should be notified as soon as possible to make room for other campers. The registration fees will **not** be refunded.

CAMP DESCRIPTIONS
